Axis 1. Transnational Routes

Research Questions: ¿How does the literary work of Latin American women writers, descendants of the Jewish and Spanish exile, reveal the topographical intention to trace and retrace routes, to describe old and new journeys, and to imagine significant places or territories that were left behind?; To what extent does their literary work propose a more inclusive map, in which their hybridity and otherness are not marginalized?

Axis 2. Transnational Networks

Research Questions: ¿How do more amical and unorganized social networks (such as informal encounters, spontaneous reunions, personal friendships) interact with more structured, regulated, and conventional social networks (such as associations, cultural centers, oficial collaborations)? How do the old social networks created by the first generation of exiles relate to the new social networks established by the daughters and granddaughters of the exile?
